Councillor Henry Lloyd (H.L) stated Humps could not be installed due to lighting issues. Mrs Gillan stated she had concerns for her Family and road safety and at some point someone could be hurt. H.L stated road painting could be completed with a cost of £3000 for signage and posts which would be paid for by the Parish. Ms N Rogers suggested if a 'Sharp bend' Sign could be added. P.C to look into ownership of the grass verges. J.B suggested building out a kerb to slow traffic, and also swapping the 'Give Way' sign on the bridge so that incoming traffic slows down rather than outgoing. J.H to look into this and discuss with Highways, although J.C voiced concerns there might not be enough roadway. Ms Rogers also suggested a community speed watch, however J.B stated the watch in Withersdale Street was cancelled as contracts for the volunteers had to be signed.
